- ✓ **Paul and Timothy, bondservants of Jesus Christ**, To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, with the bishops and deacons (Philippians 1:1).
- ✓ **Epaphras, who is one of you, a bondservant of Christ**, greets you, always laboring fervently for you in prayers, that you may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God (Colossians 4:12).
- ✓ **Paul, a bondservant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ**, according to the faith of God’s elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which accords with godliness (Titus 1:1).
- ✓ **James, a bondservant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ** (James 1:1a).
- ✓ **Simon Peter, a bondservant and apostle of Jesus Christ**, To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Peter 1:1).
- ✓ **Jude, a bondservant of Jesus Christ**, and brother of James, To those who are called, sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ (Jude 1).

Bondservants/employees/bondservants ...

1. Obedient service in the mundane. } *Every day on the job!*
2. Obedient service in reverence. } *As to Christ!*
3. Obedient service in sincerity. }
4. Obedient service before God. }
5. Obedient service doing the will of God. } *As bondservants of Christ!*
6. Obedient service knowing the reward. }
7. Obedient service regardless of earthly status. } *As to the Lord!*

Masters/employers/bosses/bondservants ...

1. See list above -”do the same things.”
2. No threats/manipulations.
3. Know where your Master is.
4. Know your Master is impartial and fair.

+ BONDSERVANTS PROCLAIMING HIS DEATH ...

Until he comes ...
