And **there is no other god besides me**, a righteous God and a Savior; **there is none besides me.** 22 Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! **For I am God, and there is no other.** 23 By myself I have sworn; from my mouth has gone out in righteousness a word that shall not return: ‘To me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear allegiance’” (Isaiah 45:18–23 ESV).

Knowing God through the place he has given us in his universe:

- Universe: All matter and energy, including the earth, the galaxies, and the contents of intergalactic space, regarded as a whole; all of space and everything in it including stars, planets, galaxies, etc.
- I find my place in the universe by honoring my God-given role in everyday life.
