OUTLINE: Building God's Kingdom in a Pagan Land (Ezra 8:1-36)!

- 1) HELP: Ezra knew that they needed godly help, 8:1-20.
 - He camped for three days as he reviewed the people and the priests, 8:15.
 - He formed a leadership team of responsible, willing men of insight, 8:16
 - By the good hand of God his leadership team found the necessary help, 8:18.
 - They found men of discretion, 8:18.
 - They found Levite teachers of the Law of God: Bible teachers, 8:15.
 - They found temple servants: saints who were called to serve, 8:18-20.
- 2) HUMILITY: Ezra knew that they needed humility, 8:21-30.
 - They humbled themselves and asked for a safe journey, 8:21, 23.
 - They acknowledged that the reality of life challenges our theological assertions, 8:22.
 - They made a detailed plan of holiness to see that the valuables were appropriately cared for, 8:24-30.
- 3) HAND OF GOD: The hand of God delivered them safely to their place of service, 8:31-32.
- 4) HONOR: They honored God with their industry, their honesty and their worship, 8:33-36.
