

OUTLINE ... Romans 5:1-5 ...

- 1) Through Jesus Christ we stand justified before God resulting in peace with God, 5:1.
- 2) Through Jesus Christ we stand in the grace of God and have full access to this grace by faith, 5:2a.
 - “Think ... Dorothy clicking her heels ...”
 - “There’s no place like grace ... there’s no place like grace ...”
- 3) Standing in our position of peace and grace we rejoice and are filled with the hope of God, 5:2b-5:5.
 - We rejoice in hope of the glory of God, 5:2b.
 - We rejoice in our sufferings, 5:3-4.
 - We are not disappointed, 5:5.
