- Some outstanding observations concerning loving our neighbor ...
 - 1. God knows our neighbors. Providence not accident.
 - 2. Compassion and mercy motivate the one who proves to be a true neighbor. Not the merit of the one in need.
 - 3. We have the opportunity to answer the same question that they asked Jesus.
 - 4. Our understanding of God and his word depends on understanding and obeying this doctrine.
 - 5. A common impediment in understanding and obeying this doctrine—loving our neighbor—is wanting to justify ourselves.
 - 6. The outstanding character trait of the person who lives this truth is mercy.
 - 7. Any form of vengeance or holding a grudge is evidence that we are not loving our neighbor, thus disobeying God.
 - 8. How we "read" the Bible can make all the difference.
