The Gospel of God Is the Gospel of GOD!

(1) Our salvation **DOES NOT** depend upon our spiritual heritage, 9:1-5.



- (2) Our salvation \underline{DOES} depend on the character of \mathbf{GOD} , 9:6–13.
 - ▶ Our spiritual inheritance is based on the promise of God, 9:6-9, cf. Genesis 18:10, Galatians 3:16-18.
 - The promise of God -> rests on the grace of God -> rests on the character of God.
 - The word of God (the promise) did not fail as God never promised that all who descended from Israel belong to Israel.
 - ▶ Our spiritual inheritance is determined and directed by God's sovereign choice, 9:10-13.
 - God chooses people for his purpose and plan.
 - *God is God*: He told one woman (Sarah) who was past child bearing age that she would have a son to carry on his promise.
 - *God is God*: He chose one twin over the other based solely on his sovereign will to carry on his promise.
- (3) Our salvation \underline{DOES} depend on the compassion and mercy of \mathbf{GOD} , 9:14–18.
- ⇒ (Romans 9:8 ESV) This means that it is not the children of the flesh who are the children of God, but the children of the promise are counted as offspring.
- → (Romans 4:16a ESV) That is why it depends on faith, in order that the promise may rest on grace and be guaranteed to all his offspring ...
