

● **PREVIEW TRIUMPHAL ENTRY: "Who is this?"**

- **HISTORICAL FACT** (c. A.D. 32)
- (Matthew 21:9-10 ESV) And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!" And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, **"Who is this?"**

● **ACTUAL TRIUMPHAL ENTRY: "Every eye will see him ..."**

- **FUTURE EVENT** (TBA—Millennial Kingdom)
- (Revelation 1:7-8) Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and **every eye will see him**, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen. "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

Outline Romans 11:11-24 ...

- 1) **The trespass of the Jews brought salvation to the Gentiles which God also used to make Israel jealous, 11:11.**
- 2) **The trespass of the Jews means rich spiritual blessings for the world and their return to blessing will mean even more, 11:12-16.**
- 3) **Our spiritual heritage, as that of Israel, is never to be a matter of pride but humility and reverence, 11:17-24.**
 - Stand fast through faith.
 - Turn toward reverence and away from pride.
 - Be thoughtful.
