(1) We count the cost and stay on task as we follow Jesus Christ, 15:22-29.

- We are to be transparent, personal and humble, 15:22-24.
- We stay on task even when God changes our plans, 15:25-29.

(2) We strive together in our prayers to God, 15:30-33.

- We pray for success in the task at hand, 15:30-31.
- We pray in order that our lives may bring joy and refreshment to those around us, 15:32.
- We cover every step of the way in the blessing of the peace of God, 15:33.

(3) We speak words of commendation and conciliation to give God's perspective with the purpose of strengthening the bonds between individual believers and churches, 16:1-16.

- We speak truth to commend the good work of God in one another's lives.
- We speak truth to heal offenses and misunderstandings between believers.
- We speak the truth to familiarize and acquaint fellow believers with each other.

[Whatever they had heard about each other, Paul wanted them to have God's perspective of the saints in these churches.]
