

How do We Prepare for Confronting the Giants in the Land?

1#: Know that the challenge is real, 17:1-11.

- There are giants in the land.

2#: Be faithful and true in the common and ordinary, 17:12-18.

- Faithful in little, faithful in much, cf. Luke 16:10.

3#: Don't focus on the giant, 17:19-24.

- Self-motivation (cheerleading, shouts and battle cries) means nothing in the presence of giants.

4#: Keep our motivation pure, 17:25-31.

- God-motivation means everything: David was at the scene per the providence of God per his faithfulness in the common and ordinary.

5#: Trust God to face the challenge at hand, 17:32-37.

- God delivers: It doesn't matter whether it is a lion, a bear, a giant or a politician.

6#: Stay true to yourself, 17:38-40.

- Stay true to what God has proved in your life.

7#: Stay true to God, 17:41-51.

- The battle is the LORD's.
