

## MEET THE GOVERNORS & KINGS ...

(Mark 13:9 ESV) But be on your guard. For they will deliver you over to councils, and you will be beaten in synagogues, and **you will stand before governors and kings for my sake**, to bear witness before them.

### Christ brought before Pilate (governor).

- (Matthew 27:1-2 ESV) When morning came, all the chief priests and the elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death. And they bound him and led him away and delivered him over to Pilate the governor.

### Paul brought before Felix (governor).

- (Acts 23:24 ESV) Also provide mounts for Paul to ride and bring him safely to Felix the governor.



### Paul brought before Festus (governor).

- (Acts 24:27 ESV) When two years had elapsed, Felix was succeeded by Porcius Festus. And desiring to do the Jews a favor, Felix left Paul in prison. (25:6) After he [Festus] stayed among them not more than eight or ten days, he went down to Caesarea. And the next day he [Festus] took his seat on the tribunal and ordered Paul to be brought.

### Paul brought before Agrippa (king).

- (Acts 25:23 ESV) So on the next day Agrippa and Bernice came with great pomp, and they entered the audience hall with the military tribunes and the prominent men of the city. Then, at the command of Festus, Paul was brought in.
