### —Pros & Cons—



#### **PROS**

- The tree was beautiful.
- Its fruit was good to eat.
- Its fruit would make her wise.

#### **CONS**

- God told them not to eat from it.

- (Genesis 3:6 NCV) **The woman** saw that the tree was beautiful, that its fruit was good to eat, and that it would make her wise. So she took some of its fruit and ate it. She also gave some of the fruit to her husband who was with her, and he ate it.
- (Genesis 2:9 ESV) And out of the ground the LORD God made to spring up every tree that is pleasant to the sight and good for food. The tree of life was in the midst of the garden, **and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.**
- (Genesis 2:17 ESV) But of **the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat**, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.
- (2 Corinthians 11:3 ESV) But I am afraid that as **the serpent deceived Eve** by his cunning, your thoughts will be led astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ.
- (1 Timothy 2:11–14 ESV) Let a woman learn quietly with all submissiveness. I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet. For Adam was formed first, then Eve; **and Adam was not deceived, but the woman was deceived** and became a transgressor.
