GOD WORD: WRITTEN DOWN WITH PURPOSE AND INTENT!

- (John 20:30-31 ESV) Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
- (John 21:25 NCV) There are many other things Jesus did. If every one of them were written down, I suppose the whole world would not be big enough for all the books that would be written.
- (1 Corinthians 10:11 ESV) Now these things happened to them as an example, but they were written down for our instruction, on whom the end of the ages has come.
- (2 Timothy 3:16-17 ESV) All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.
- (1 John 5:13 ESV) I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life.
- (2 John 9 NCV) Anyone who goes beyond Christ's teaching and does not continue to follow only his teaching does not have God. But whoever continues to follow the teaching of Christ has both the Father and the Son.
