AN OVERVIEW OF REVELATION 1:1-20 ...

- 1. PROLOGUE: First things first, 1:1-3.
 - The central idea (or overarching theme): The revelation of Jesus Christ.
 - The stated purpose: Given by God for Jesus Christ to show his servants the things which are imminent.
 - The means of transmission: John was commissioned by an angel to be a witness.
 - The blessing: To the one who reads aloud, those who hear, those who keep.
- 2. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>: John speaks the grace and peace of our triune God to the seven churches in Asia, 1:4-5a.
- 3. <u>Doxology</u>: John rejoices in the work of Christ and in anticipation of his coming, 1:5b-8.
- 4. <u>Scene/Setting</u>: John begins to describe the scene before him, his vision and the loud voice behind him, 1:9-11.
- 5. <u>DESCRIPTION</u>: John turns to see the voice and describes the One speaking to him, 1:12-16.
- 6. <u>HOLY COMMISSIONING</u>: John's encounter with Jesus Christ glorified prepares him to witness, 1:17-19.
 - FEAR/Reverence: John dropped at the feet of Christ like a dead man.
 - **COURAGE/Assurance:** John was charged with holy boldness from his encounter with the Holy One of Israel.
 - **SUBMISSION/Authority:** John is commissioned by the One who is the Sovereign Lord of the universe, who lives forever, who holds the keys to death and the place of death.
- 7. EXPLANATION: Our glorified Lord explains the mystery of the seven stars that John saw, 1:20.

- (Isaiah 41:4 ESV) Who has performed and done this, calling the generations from the beginning? I, the LORD, the first, and with the last; I am he.
