But you have come to Mount Zion *and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem,* and to innumerable angels in festal gathering.

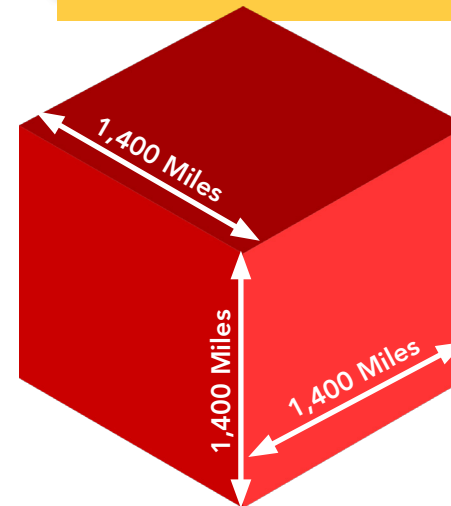
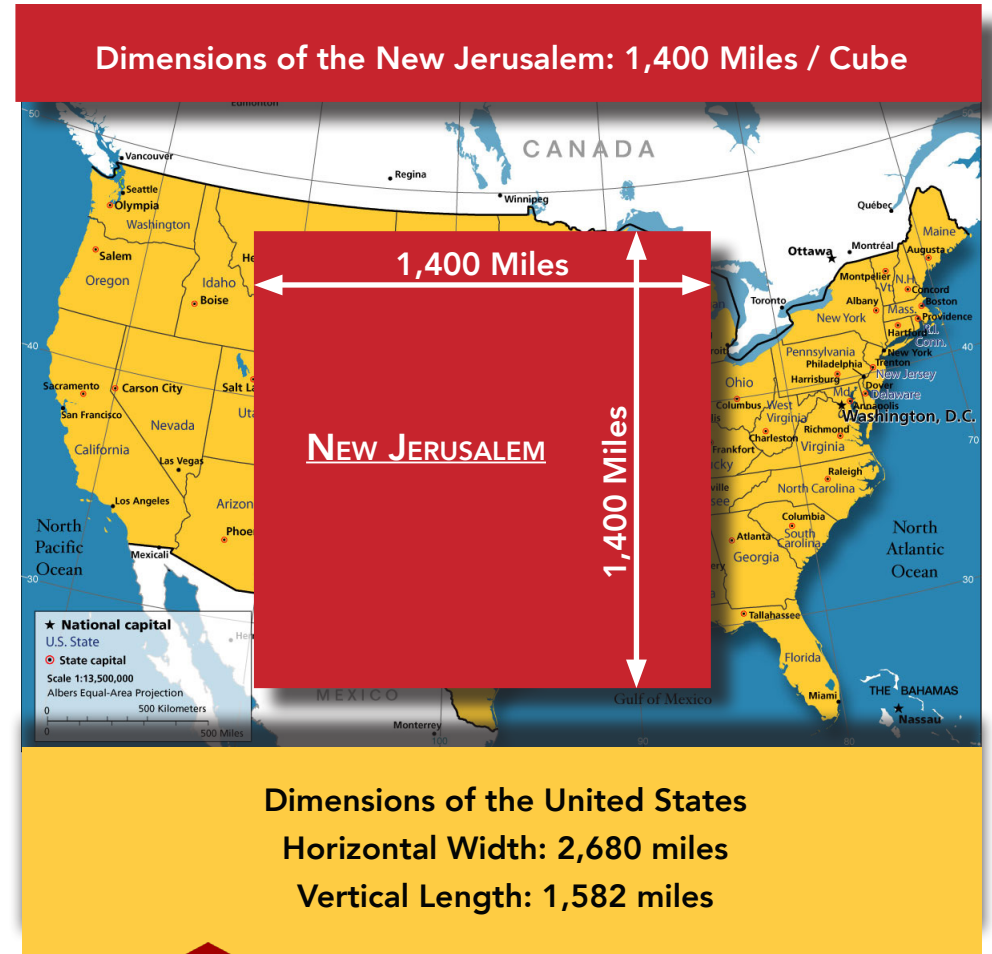
(Hebrews 12:22 ESV)
