



**L**et the wicked change their ways and banish the very thought of doing wrong. Let them turn to the LORD that he may have mercy on them. Yes, turn to our God, for he will forgive generously. “My thoughts are nothing like your thoughts,” says the LORD. “And my ways are far beyond anything you could imagine. For just as the heavens are higher than the earth, so my ways are higher than your ways and my thoughts higher than your thoughts” (Isaiah 55:7-9 NLT).

**Y**our steadfast love, O LORD, extends to the heavens, your faithfulness to the clouds. Your righteousness is like the mountains of God; your judgments are like the great deep; man and beast you save, O LORD. How precious is your steadfast love, O God! The children of mankind take refuge in the shadow of your wings (Psalm 36:5-7 ESV).

**I** will give thanks to you, O Lord, among the peoples; I will sing praises to you among the nations. For your steadfast love is great to the heavens, your faithfulness to the clouds. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens! Let your glory be over all the earth (Psalm 57:9-11 ESV)!

**F**or as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us. As a father shows compassion to his children, so the LORD shows compassion to those who fear him. For he knows our frame; he remembers that we are dust (Psalm 103:11-14 ESV).

**M**y heart is steadfast, O God! I will sing and make melody with all my being! Awake, O harp and lyre! I will awake the dawn! I will give thanks to you, O LORD, among the peoples; I will sing praises to you among the nations. For your steadfast love is great above the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the clouds. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens! Let your glory be over all the earth (Psalm 108:1–5 ESV)

- (Psalm 89:1–2 ESV) I will sing of the steadfast love of the LORD, forever; with my mouth I will make known **your faithfulness** to all generations. For I said, “Steadfast love will be built up forever; **in the heavens you will establish your faithfulness.**”
- (Deuteronomy 32:1–5 ESV) Give ear, O heavens, and I will speak, and let the earth hear the words of my mouth. May my teaching drop as the rain, my speech distill as the dew, like gentle rain upon the tender grass, and like showers upon the herb. For I will proclaim the name of the LORD; ascribe greatness to our God! The Rock, his work is perfect, for all his ways are justice. **A God of faithfulness** and without iniquity, just and upright is he. They have dealt corruptly with him; they are no longer his children because they are blemished; they are a crooked and twisted generation.
- (Psalm 25:10 ESV) **All the paths of the LORD are steadfast love and faithfulness,** for those who keep his covenant and his testimonies.
- (Psalm 26:3 ESV) For your steadfast love is before my eyes, **and I walk in your faithfulness.**
- (Psalm 33:4 ESV) For the word of the LORD is upright, **and all his work is done in faithfulness.**
- (Psalm 40:11 ESV) As for you, O LORD, you will not restrain your mercy from me; **your steadfast love and your faithfulness will ever preserve me!**
- (Psalm 86:15 ESV) But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and **abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.**
- (Psalm 89:5–8 ESV) Let the heavens praise your wonders, O LORD, **your faithfulness in the assembly of the holy ones!** For who in the skies can be compared to the LORD? Who among the heavenly beings is like the LORD, a God greatly to be feared in the council of the holy ones, and awesome above all who are around him? O LORD God of hosts, who is mighty as you are, O LORD, **with your faithfulness all around you?**
- (Psalm 89:14 ESV) Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; **steadfast love and faithfulness go before you.**
- (Psalm 91:1–6 ESV) He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say to the LORD, “My refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust.” For he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence. He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge; **his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.** You will not fear the terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor the destruction that wastes at noonday.
- (Isaiah 11:5 ESV) Righteousness shall be the belt of his waist, **and faithfulness the belt of his loins.**
- (Lamentations 3:22–24 ESV) The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; **great is your faithfulness.** “The LORD is my portion,” says my soul, “therefore I will hope in him.”
- (Proverbs 20:6 ESV) **Many a man proclaims his own steadfast love, but a faithful man who can find?**
- (Psalm 31:23–24 ESV) Love the LORD, all you his saints! **The LORD preserves the faithful** but abundantly repays the one who acts in pride. Be strong, and let your heart take courage, all you who wait for the LORD!
- (Psalm 101:6 ESV) **I will look with favor on the faithful in the land,** that they may dwell with me; he who walks in the way that is blameless shall minister to me.
- (Proverbs 25:13 ESV) Like the cold of snow in the time of harvest is **a faithful messenger** to those who send him; he refreshes the soul of his masters.
- (Matthew 25:21 ESV) His master said to him, “Well done, **good and faithful servant.** You have been **faithful over a little;** I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.”
- (Luke 16:10 ESV) **One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much,** and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much.
- (1 Corinthians 4:2 ESV) **Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful.**
- (1 Timothy 3:11 ESV) Their wives likewise must be dignified, not slanderers, but sober-minded, **faithful in all things.**
- (Revelation 2:10 ESV) Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and for ten days you will have tribulation. Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life.
- (Revelation 2:13 ESV) I know where you dwell, where Satan’s throne is. Yet you hold fast my name, and **you did not deny my faith even in the days of Antipas my faithful witness,** who was killed among you, where Satan dwells.
- (Revelation 17:14 ESV) They will make war on the Lamb, and the Lamb will conquer them, for he is Lord of lords and King of kings, **and those with him are called and chosen and faithful.**
